Finances

 - This might still mean that \$50 went missing but we're in the positive so maybe it's fine
- Money we have
 - Total: \$1568.50
 - Cash: \$1008.50
 - UCC Accounts: \$560
- To be reimbursed
 - \$12.40 to Unigames
 - \$8-10 to Panto
- Tav doesn't send out invoices until the end of the month
 - So we will wait until then to pay the tav and divide up the profits
 - Money to stay in Unigames/UCC until then!
- Potential Tav costs
 - \$300 for venue
